### **Prize Distribution**

Top prize is entry into the World Series of Poker plus \$2,000 travel cash for a total prize value of \$12,000. (WSOP tickets are non-refundable. Once tickets are registered with HLC they are non-transferable. )

- ° The exact prize distribution will be announced and posted after the tournament ticket sales are closed but before the conclusion of the second level of play.
- ° In each tournament there will be one top prize awarded for every 12k in prize pool money.
  - ° The remainder will be distributed to players at the final table.

### **Tax Liability on Prizes**

The Internal Revenue Service Code requires a W-2g for each person that is paid out more that \$5,000 in net tournament winnings (winnings reduced by the amount of the wager or buy-in). Each winner must present two forms of identification. Acceptable forms of identification are a valid driver's license, social security card or voter's registration card. An IRS Form W9 must be completed for all players who win. Any player unable to provide their social security number or TIN will be subject to 28% backup withholding on the full amount of the winnings from the tournament. A 30% withholding must be held for all non-US citizens. If the winner does not have identification, payout can not be made until valid identification is obtained. When tournament winnings are made in non-cash form, such as jewelry or home electronics, the items actual cost is used to calculate the winnings.

Amounts paid in cash will not exceed \$5,000, balance to be paid by check.

Net winnings of \$5,000 or less are not subject to reporting, withholding, or backup withholding.

All liability for payment of any taxes associated with any award or receipt of a prize or any portion thereof shall be the responsibility of the prize winner. Neither Jacksonville Greyhound Racing, Inc. nor HLC and its affiliates are in any way responsible for any tax liability associated with the award or receipt of any prize for which it provides goods or services associated with tournament events.
